All students also have to submit a latest CV. Educational certificates. All educational certificates provided should be in original and a set of copies. <p>The documents to include are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IELTS scores • Class 10 Mark sheet/Certificates. • Class 12 Mark sheet/Certificates. • Graduation Mark sheet/Certificates. • Post Graduate Mark sheet/Certificate. • Other courses and Diplomas done. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Evidence of Employment – Originals and attested copies If the student is working, and taking leave to study, provide an original letter of leave from the employer on company letterhead. If student is resigning from the job, a work reference from the employer on company letterhead is a must. The company's address and phone number must be included on the letter. Portfolio - Examples of completed Video Projects for consideration.
